LEGAL & GOVERNANCE

- A statutory guidance drafting meeting was held to review current guidance and identify a plan to take forward the development of the SUSR statutory guidance.
- Procurement process underway to identify contractor to develop SUSR statutory guidance with key stakeholder subgroup.
- Correspondence continues with Home Office to review WG proposals and SUSR templates.
- Key SUSR governance documents now drafted and shared for comment.
- Working with Geldards to draft Terms of Use Agreement for WSR users and Data Protection Impact Assessment for the SUSR process.
