Sexual Violence is any sexual act or activity which is unwanted and which has not been consented to. Sexual Violence can affect anyone, at any stage of their lives, regardless of gender or sexuality. A victim may experience one incident of sexual violence or many.

Approximately 85,000 women and 12,000 men are raped in England and Wales every year; roughly 11 rapes (of adults alone) every hour (assaults by penetration and attempts)
